## Zephyr Point Summer 2022 Youth

Grades: going into **1st-6th grades** Camp Zephyr is a high paced program, with lots of movement, and social interaction it can be very exhausting for young campers. They require that campers have completed kindergarten before they can attend day camp with us.

Camp Zephyr is a 5-day, non-residential (not overnight), Christian based, summer day-camp program for first through sixth graders. **Children must have completed kindergarten to attend camp.** The program runs Monday – Friday, weekly from June 13th to August 5th. Camper check-in begins at 8:45am and pick-up is between 4:00 and 4:15 pm.

Each week campers will get to experience Skits, Song, Games, Crafts, Swimming, Rotating Morning Activities & Trail Talks.

Cost: \$280/week (\$220 week of 4th of July)

They offer an early drop-off option (starting at 7:45 am) and late pick-up option (concluding at 5:15 pm). Choose one (early arrival or late pickup) for \$30 or do both for \$50 for the week!

## **Sugarloaf Camp**

July 10 to 16 & July 16-23

Sugarloaf Fine Arts Camp concentrates in Art, Music, Photography, Acting, Videography, Acting, Videography, Dance, and Singing. Apply at [sugarloafcamp.org](http://sugarloafcamp.org)

Applications accepted until midnight on March 9, 2022.

The 2022 weekly Camp Fee will be \$500/camper plus an additional \$25 for campers registered in B/W Photography, Digital Photography, Digital Slideshow, Digital Audio and Video Arts.

Sugarloaf Fine Arts Camp brings a unique camp experience to the students of El Dorado County. The week-long sessions provide a supportive environment for campers to expand their fine arts skills and to experiment with new ones. The camp location, in the pines of the Sierra Nevada Mountains at an altitude of 3,600 feet, allows campers to breathe fresh air while escaping from the hustle, bustle and technology of daily living.

The camper's week focuses on their specialty major and an elective of their choice and includes a daily recreation period and nightly campfire program. Sugarloaf is an overnight camp that runs Sunday to Saturday for both of the two sessions. The staff includes many El Dorado County teachers and many Sugarloaf alumni.

To be eligible, students will need to have completed fifth grade and not yet completed twelfth grade by July of the year of camp.

Sugarloaf Fine Arts Camp is administered by the El Dorado County Office of Education (EDCOE). Priority for enrollment is given to El Dorado County students with out-of-county applicants also eligible. Sugarloaf Fine Arts Camp takes place at the beautiful Sly Park Environmental Education Center in Pollock Pines, California.
